London Gymnastics Ltd. is the governing body of gymnastics for the region, providing governance and accountability to affiliated clubs. The region covers the area within the boundaries of all the London boroughs.

London Gymnastics is served by a volunteer force made up of London Gymnastics Directors and the Management Committee, a Joint Technical Committee, the Regional Technical Committees, the Event Teams and supported by Service Providers.

London Gymnastics is governed by the Articles of Incorporation, the Committee Procedures and Regulations (CPR), the London Gymnastics Policies and Standards of Conduct.

Affiliation to London Gymnastics opens up a wealth of benefits. Member Clubs receive a fantastic competition programme and unrivalled technical know-how for each discipline of gymnastics. The region offers competitive programmes in all disciplines, at all levels including grass roots and 'Gymnastics for All' (GFA) activities. Plus, national events that include the well renowned London Festival of Gymnastics, Men's London Open and Development Open competition. Through our partnership with British Gymnastics, we are able to provide the very best Coach and Judge education system and a wealth of volunteering opportunities.

For London Gymnastics affiliated clubs we provide:

- Funding for career and volunteer development via the Platten Scholarship.
- Proactive communications support by varied digital media channels.
- Webinars and Zoom meetings on relevant topics.
- Special Annual Projects.
- Support on legal, financial and integrity matters, including health and safety.
- A developmental programme of events across all disciplines.
- A comprehensive competition Structure leading into the National Competition Programme.
- Entry into regional events and competitions across all disciplines.
- Entry to Club conferences, awards events, coach clinics, judging clinics and regional training.

The Joint Technical Committee (JTC) is responsible for the technical programmes and regulations at Regional Level, ensuring that the objects of British Gymnastics are administered in relation to technical matters, and to provide a forum for discussion at regional level.

The JTC is made up of the Chairmen of the current Technical Committees and Event Teams.

The Technical Committees (TC's) are responsible for the day-to-day running of the disciplines, ensuring compliance with British Gymnastics technical rules and regulations. They set the annual competition and events calendar and support clubs and coaches.

The Event Teams are responsible for the annual events:

- The London Festival of Gymnastics
- The Men's London Open

Current Regional London Gymnastics Disciplines:

Acrobatic Gymnastics: General Gymnastics: Men's Artistic: Rhythmic Gymnastics: Trampolining and Tumbling: Women's Artistic

Each technical Committee produces an annual handbook, runs Regional Development and Competition Programmes which offer opportunities for performance at all levels.

All disciplines (apart from GfA) have a Regional, National, and International Framework.

Currently, we do not have Technical Committees for Team Gym or Aerobics within London, but there are clubs that compete in those disciplines.

Club Affiliation: is made via the London Gymnastics Membership Portal

- Clubs must be registered with British Gymnastics at the time of application.
- A Club's main venue must be within a London Borough.
- Clubs must be in good standing with British Gymnastics/ London Gymnastics and comply with London Gymnastics Policies, Event Rules and Standards of Conduct.
- Clubs must register all its gymnasts and coaches appropriately with British Gymnastics.
- London Gymnastics is unable to affiliate clubs that hold a membership with any gymnastic organisation other than British Gymnastics.
- The Regional Affiliation of a club is determined by club capacity and is aligned to the British Gymnastics club registration banding.
- The Club is affiliated to the region, not individuals.
- Affiliation runs from January December.
- Application and payments are made via the London Gymnastics Membership Portal.
- It is the club's responsibility to ensure that information on the British Gymnastics GymNet is accurate and current.
